From the middle of October 6Towns Credit Union will start operating local 'drop in' points across the Grace Mary to Lion Farm area.

Anyone, over the age of 18, will be able to open an account and apply for a loan straight away.



6Towns have been operating across Sandwell for over 10 years and have helped many families to deal with unexpected bills and to put a little money aside per week so that they have saved for events like Christmas.

6Towns is open to everyone, no matter what your credit rating. Loans can be arranged to ensure that the repayments are easy to afford and within your means to repay, whilst savings account can be opened from the very young as there are no age restrictions.

As part of 6Towns commitment to help individuals and families to budget, it is planned from January 2017 that 6Towns will be able to help you set up a budget plan and help those that are vulnerable in our community that struggle to pay bills on time. By using the 6Towns current account with its Priority Account which will 'ring fence' the money for essential bills this leaves any remaining money to be spent through their Debit card and provides 'Peace of Mind'.
